Deadline for Submission of Abstracts: 15th June 2010

Guidelines for Submission of Abstracts

- Papers to be submitted must be on intensive care related topics.
- No limit is imposed on the number of abstracts submitted by individuals.
- Abstracts are to be submitted in English only.
- Abstracts will only be accepted after payment of registration fees. If the abstract is subsequently not accepted for presentation, and the author wishes to cancel, the registration fee will be refunded to the author.
- Scheduling details and guidelines for the final preparation of accepted presentations will be included with the notification of acceptance.
- The final selection will be the responsibility of the Organising Committee.

Where appropriate, the abstracts should contain the following:

- A statement of the objectives of the study.
- A description of the methods used.
- A summary of the results obtained.
- A statement of the conclusions reached.

Abstract preparation and submission

- Abstracts can only be submitted via our online submission system.
- Abstracts should be prepared using the abstract template which will be available for download on our website.
- Abstracts must not be more than 300 words (inclusive of title and author(s) name).
- Title must be in bold capital letters at the top of the abstract.
- Author(s) name and institution. Maximum of 5 authors can be listed.
- Presenting author name must be underlined.
- Full formatting instructions can be found on the abstract template.
- Graphs, tables and illustrations cannot be included in the abstract.
